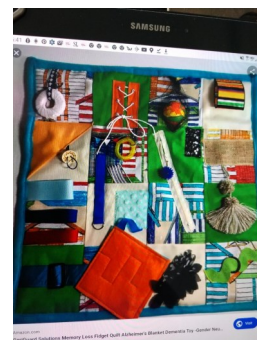
October:

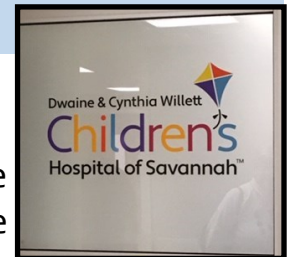
