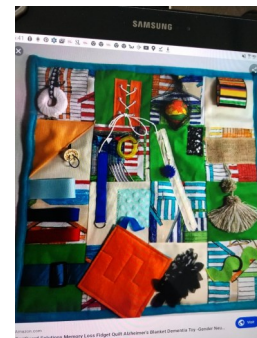
October:

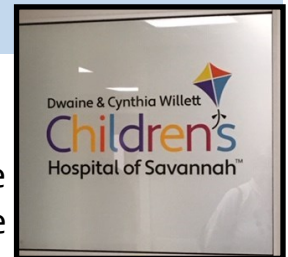
