October workshop will be the second part of the Mondo Bag project. If you missed part one but would like to participate, contact Renee to learn how to see the video for part one. The cost is \$20.



November workshop will be the Fidget Quilt with instruction by Carol Vondeylen. The fee will be \$20. 
In the meantime, check out her website at **nancymahoney.com** to learn more about her talents and the Class. Check out the About Nancy on her webpage.


