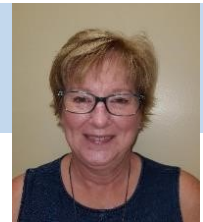
Welcome to our newest members, Karen Hayes and Velinda Burnsed!!! We are glad that you are joining us and look forward to getting to know you better!
