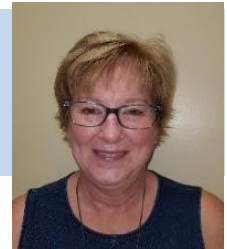

After Meeting Workshops and Sew-Ons

April: Fabric Painting with Terry Duncan - I'm excited to announce that the fabric painting workshop has finally arrived! Terry Duncan will guide us as we learn methods to successfully painting unique designs on our projects. Terry has prepared the fabric for our workshop. Terry and I will provide some brushes and the Inktense paints that will create a softer, more blended look than the old-fashioned fabric paints. This type of painting can be used on quilts, clothing, and a variety of fabric crafts. We have some slots open. If you're interested, the fee is \$20.00, with an additional \$6.00 supply fee for use of the Inktense paints that Terry and I bring.



May: Design Boards with Cindy Ochoa - Cindy will lead us through the creation of a 12"×12" foam core design board. It's a very light-weight, portable means of transporting, displaying and developing quilt blocks; the board can even keep the pieces in place in an upright position. It's perfect for working on those tricky blocks where it's so easy to get the pieces in the wrong position. The fee for this workshop is \$20.00. Cindy will have an example to show at the April meeting.

June: Jelly Roll Placemats and Rugs with Jan Smart - This versatile method can make placemats and rugs in an infinite variety of shapes and sizes. I will introduce you to 3 styles of the Jelly Roll method and explain some tricks for making them turn out 'just right'. This workshop requires a sewing machine, a jelly roll of fabrics with a little pre-preparations done, several full bobbins of thread, scissors, thread, and machine needles for jeans-weight fabric. The fee will be \$20.00.
