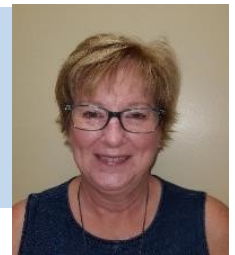

After Meeting Workshops and Sew-Ons

November- Jelly Roll Rug Placemats with Jan Smart

Our final workshop of 2021 will be an instruction in using the jelly roll rug method to create a placemat or start a rug. We'll begin with lunch while I give some preparatory information. Then we'll start by adding the batting strips to the joined jelly roll fabric strips to create the cord that is the foundation for your rug or placemat. You'll determine whether you want a round or an oval shape and begin sewing. You'll leave with either the center of a rug or a placemat.

A sewing machine capable of zigzag stitching is required.

The workshop fee is \$20.00, non-refundable. There's no supply fee. The class is limited to 15 participants.
