In 2021 we had a great variety of topics for our after-meeting workshops; fabric painting, design boards, Flipping Out bag, paper piecing, Scrappy Spider and Pumpkin placemats Tips, Techniques to improve your quilts and jelly roll rug/placemats. A HUGE 'thank you to Terry Duncan, Cindy Ochoa, Theresa Sapp, Renee Christensen, Julie Dobson and Lanette Edens for leading workshops this year. And thanks to Carol Von Deylen for offering to instruct us in making Fidget Quilts, though illness cancelled that workshop.

January 2022: Community Outreach sewing of pillowcases and nursing covers. Please bring fabric for these projects as there were no pillowcase kits available at December's meeting. Also bring your sewing machine and tools. There will also be a Valentine's Day project that is free. If you want to participate in the Valentine's Day project, bring two (or more) 10" square fabrics and your machine. It's super easy and fast so you'll have a pillow cover or table runner ready in time for your Valentine's day! No fee for these workshops.

February 2022: Improvisational Quilting with Julie Dobson. Julie will instruct us on how to make a quilt in this new method. Very creative! March 2022: Ombre Table runner with Jeanne Reinisch. Jeanne will show us how to make this striking multi-colored table runner using a piece of ombre fabric. I haven't taken a photo of it yet, but will post the photo when I get it. Fee is \$20.00.

I delivered 21 nursing covers, 23 caps, and 1 blanket to Memorial Hospital in the month of December. Thanks to all the sewers, knitters, and crocheters; 163 nursing covers, 119 caps, and 6 blankets were delivered in 2021!

I did check on the desired size of blankets. The "bereavement" blankets may be any size, as sometimes the baby is just placed on the blanket and other times wrapped in it. As to desired colors, solid or multi-colored are fine just no "neon" colors.

Remember, donations of color-fast fabrics are always need to make kits.
