## **After Meeting Workshops and Sew-Ons**

It is a great method for creating a modern looking quilt piece in a easy, fun and fast way. And Julie shared a site for help in selecting colors. I love that Julie's teaching style makes me feel as though I may make something very different from anyone else's, but I'm never making a mistake.

### **March 2022: Ombre Table Runner with Jeanne Reinisch**

Jeanne took one piece of gradient fabric and turned out a simple table runner with a sophisticated color design. There will be a general post on the SQG website regarding fabric, sewing tools, etc. No need for a pattern, just a ruler and rotary cutter. The posting will offer suggestions for selecting fabrics so start your fabric search now. If you're looking for an easy project that can be completed quickly, this is the one! ### **April 2022: Clutch Wallet with Marilyn Smith**
