Sulky Threads Presents Thread Sketching Free-Motion Basics Couching & Creating a Landscape

Mark your calendar for Friday, September 9th and join us for a fascinating class offered by Sulky of America. You need your sewing machine with zig-zag capability. We will learn the following:

- cursive writing by machine,
- basic free motion,
- straight stitch techniques,
- free-motion quilting techniques using different thread types,
- fill in stitching techniques

and an introduction to thread-sketched portraits and pen and ink tangles.

In the afternoon, we will learn basic raw-edge applique, layering techniques, machine-fed/free motion couching and creating textured fabrics.

WOW what a lot to cover! Participants' kits are required for the class. The cost for the kit is \$26@. The retail value is \$67. Registration fee is \$50 which is due at sign up. Payment for the kit must be received by September 2.

Registration will begin at our June Quilt Guild Meeting. Class size is limited to 25 students so secure your spot by signing up early.
