### Sulky Threads Presents Thread Sketching Free-Motion Basics Couching & Creating a Landscape

Join us for a fascinating class offered by Sulky of America with Nancy Sapin. You need your sewing machine with zig-zag capability.

We will learn the following:

- cursive writing by machine,
- basic free motion,
- straight stitch techniques,
- free-motion quilting techniques using different thread types,
- fill in stitching techniques

and an introduction to thread-sketched portraits and pen and ink tangles.

In the afternoon, we will learn

- basic raw-edge applique,
- layering techniques,
- machine-fed/free motion couching and creating textured fabrics.

**WOW** what a lot to cover! Participants' kits are required for the class. The cost for the kit is \$26@. The retail value is \$67. Registration fee is \$50 which is due at sign up. Payment for the kit must be received by August 13<sup>th</sup>.

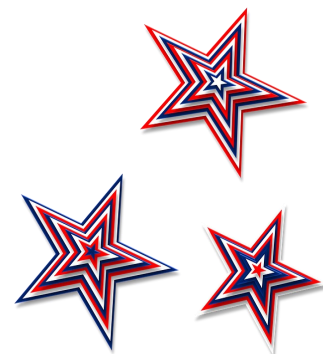
Memorial NICU has let us know they are always in need of premie hats/caps, especially colors for boys. Any knitters/crochet's might want to take note of this.

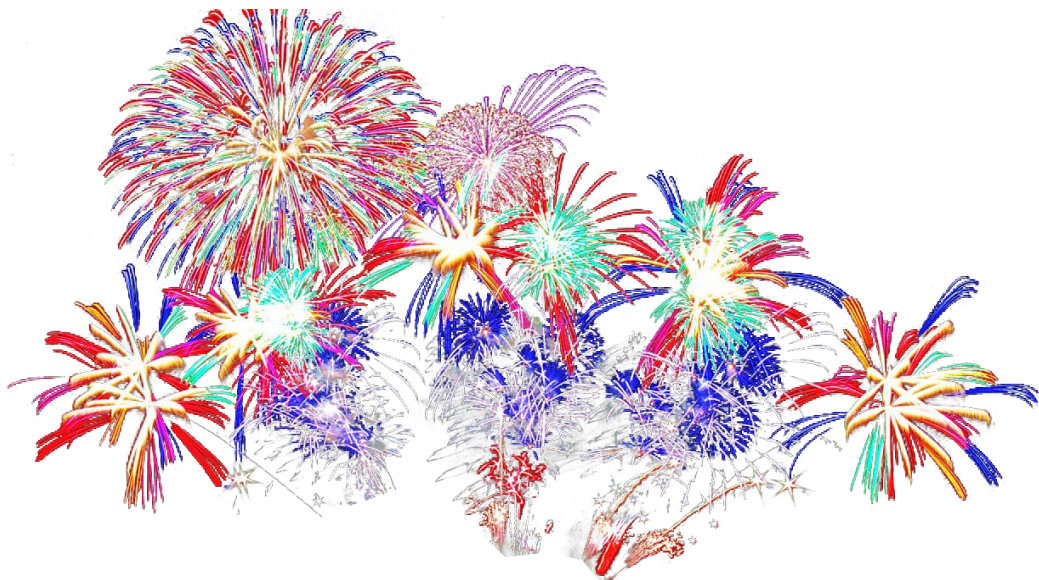
