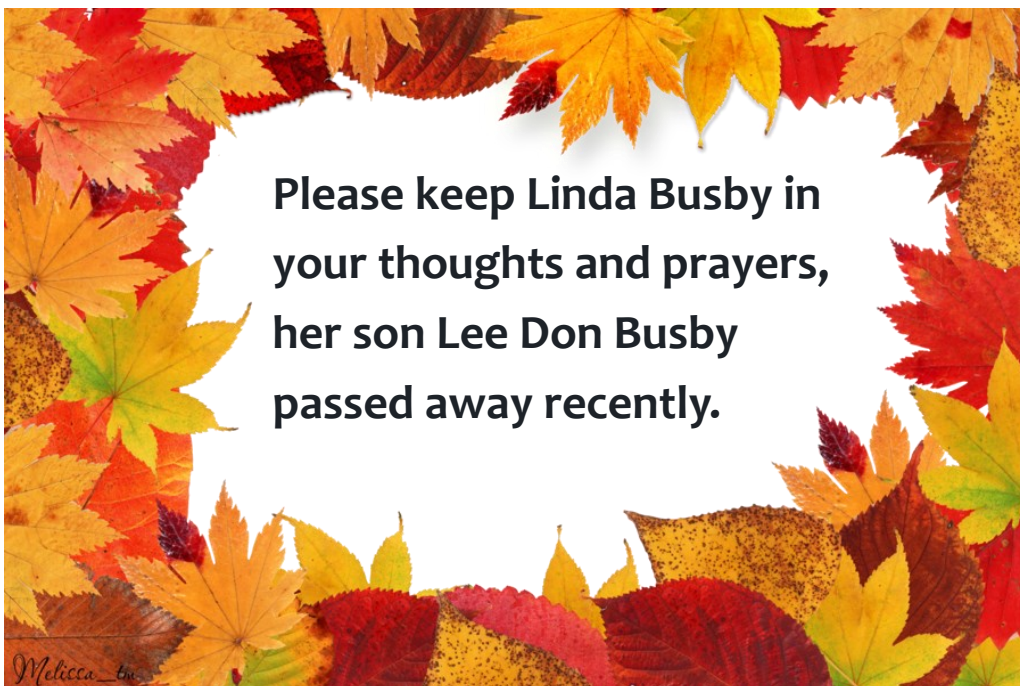
Thank you, Lanette, for your instructive workshop helping our members to improve the quality of their quilts!
