#### **Block of the Month: Mayflower**

# 7 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle unfinished

### Bring to the May Meeting



Note: It's important not to skip 'squaring up' where this is noted. It's the best way to ensure the pattern pieces line up and there are uniform sized blocks!


### Step 1 – Make Half Square Triangles (HST)

Place background white fabric and flower or stem fabric right sides together

Use pieces: D+E, H+I, K+J

Mark a diagonal line corner to corner

Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the marked line



### **White Background Fabric**

<u>Squares</u>	<u>Rectangles</u>
2 ¾" - cut 2 for A, J	1 ½" x 5 ½"- cut 2 for F
3 ½" – cut 1 for E	2 ¼" x 2 ¾" – cut 2 for N
2 ½" – cut 1 for I	Cut 2 - triangle pattern piece for M – with fabric
	right sides together

## **Stem & Leaf Fabric**

# <u>Squares</u> 2 ¾" - cut 1 for K 2 ½" – cut 1 for H

Rectangles

1" x 4 ½"- cut 1 for G


Cut 2 - triangle pattern **piece for L** – with fabric right sides together

# **Flower Fabric**


**Squares** 

3 ½"- cut 2 for D, C

2 ¼" – cut 1 for B




All seams are sewn at ¼" unless otherwise noted!



Step 2 – Cut, Press & Square the HST Cut on the diagonal line corner to corner Press seam towards the darker fabric SQUARE UP the pieces, cutting off the 'ears' D+E = square to 3" H+I = square to 2" K+J = square to 2 ¼"

Set the HST aside



# Step 3 – Sew the Flower Top Section

Piece **A** - Mark a diagonal line corner to corner and cut


Sew 1 of **A** to **B**, right sides together & press to the dark fabric


\*\* Piece **C**- Mark a diagonal line corner to corner and cut (Added note from original)

Sew one of C to AB, press towards C

Sew the remaining **A** to **B**, right sides together & press towards B

Sew the remaining **C** to complete the section







### Step 4 – Sew the Flower Sections

Sew HST pieces **DE** together as shown, press seam

Sew Flower Top to Bottom & Press

Square to 5 ½" x 5 ½"

Finish by sewing **F** to the sides, as shown & press




# Step 5 – Tricky Triangle Leaves

Sew pieces **M** + **L** with fabric right sides together as shown, press towards the darker fabric

# Step 6 – Leaves & Stems

Lay out the pieces as noted below.

Sew them together and press.



All seams are sewn at ¼" unless otherwise noted!






Step 7 – Flower + Leaves = Mayflower

Lay out the top and bottom as shown.

Sew them together and press.

'Unfinished' piece should measure 7  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ "
