May's workshop is "when your quilt talks to you". Rita will be helping us plan our quilting design and execute it whether free motion or with rulers.

Workshop elements

- A quilt or quilt block to use when designing your quilt plan.
- Review quilting design elements including background, motif and fills.
- Review and tryout elements of ruler and walking foot use and free motion quilting.
- Make a quilting design.
- Discuss other issues such as marking, thread, batting, practice and fear.

Bring your pencil, walking foot and rulers if you have any. It's going to be a great learning experience and will set us off on the right foot for our quilting adventure.

June's workshop is "One Block Wonder". Lot's of info to follow.

May's fat quarter color or design is **FLOWERS**. Bet you didn't guess that one.
