Saturday, June 10th, please feel free to invite a friend to join us for a wonderful presentation by Marie Bostwick and celebrate her newest book *Esme Cahill Fails Spectacularly*. A York Times and USA Today bestselling author, Marie Bostwick, will speak about a writing life and how her love of quilting has sparked her creativity and influenced her books.

Her new novel, ***Esme Cahill Fails Spectacularly***, tells the story of two young women from different eras, each struggling to carve out a life for themselves in the arts. After losing everything she holds dear – her marriage, her job, and her professional reputation – failed writer turned successful book editor, Esme Cahill, returns to Asheville, North Carolina and the rustic lakeside lodge where she was raised by her loving, eccentric grandparents, George and Adele. Upon discovering a hidden trove of museum-worthy quilts, Esme uncovers an untold chapter in her late grandmother's story, that of a gifted artist who never received her due.

Marie's novels have received numerous awards and been translated into eleven different languages. One of her novels, *The Second Sister*, was adapted into the 2018 Hallmark Hall of Fame movie, *Christmas Everlasting*.
