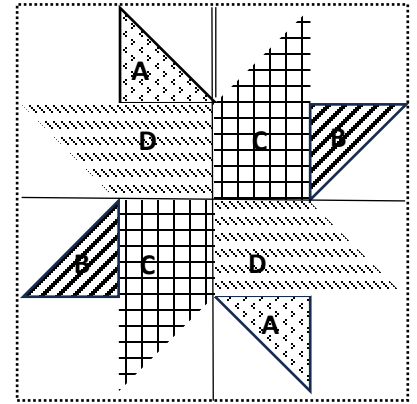
Fabric needs: ‘close in shade’ (analogous) small print fabrics & white background

**** (8)** 4 ½” squares - white background fabric

(2) 5” squares - white background fabric

(1 each) 5” square - print fabrics A & B

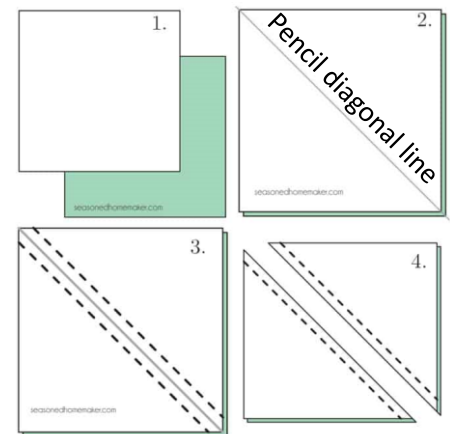
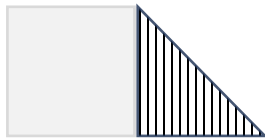
(2 each) 4 ½” x 8 ½” rectangles – print fabrics C & D



Step 1

Make HSTs (half square triangles) using pieces A, B and (2) 5” white background; sew a scant ¼” seam on either side of the pencil line; slit into 2; press towards the ‘print’ side.

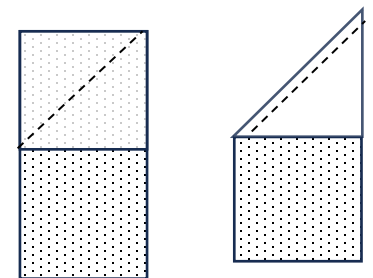
Trim to 4 ½” square. Sew each to the left side of a 4 ½” white square; press



Step 2

Sew the 4 ½” white background squares to the 4 ½” x 8 ½” rectangles.

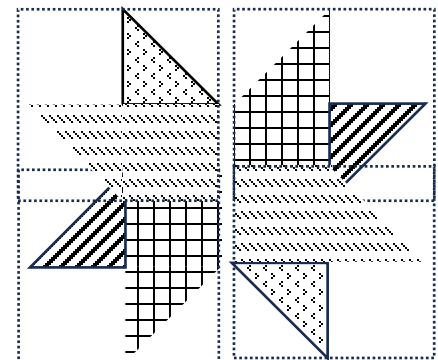
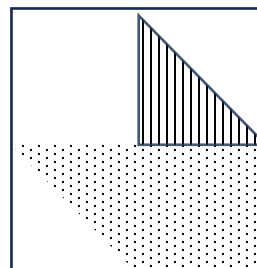
****Mark a diagonal line on the remaining 4 ½” squares & sew on the pencil line to ‘snowball’ the rectangle;** trim the seam to ¼”; press towards the ‘print’ side.



Step 3

Sew the Step 1 and Step 2 sections together.

Do this 4 times & press towards the larger rectangle side.



Arrange the newly made 4 sections, match seams, and sew together. Press seams.
